Lecture / Demonstration Topics

Where we've been and where we are going – This talk will cover a bit of history as well as a little bit of what has happened in the PLC world in the last year.

The Leading Edge – This is demonstration of the newest features in the LIMS in both client server, prelog, and .NET.

Keeping up with Technology – New development directions will be discussed, e.g. Cloud based LIMS, RFID, geographical analysis, and tablet friendly software.

Efficiency through Batching – This will highlight several ways the LIMS can be used to complete work in batch with an eye toward how you can improve efficiency. Included are batch case creation, batch review, batch task creation, and batch matrix entry.

LIMS Infrastructure – This talk unpacks the internals of the LIMS system. The hardware, the system software and application software are all explored. Some usef tools for managing you system are demonstrated and provided for you to being home

What's the Point? – In this session you will be presented with thought provoking questions that address reasons behind why you use the LIMS the way you do and why you might want to use some of the new features that are available.

Integrated Asset Tracking – Survey of using Laboratory Asset Management (LAM) and all the places in the LIMS you can link to it.

Publishing and Notification – Various communication tools such as action Items, notifications, emails, and web distribution are covered in this talk. Essentially, you learn how to get the information out of the LIMS and into the hands of the people who need it.

Image Integration – Discussion and demonstration of PLC's Image Vault and Matrix Image annotation features. Also covered are interfaces to third party imaging products.

Taking Inventory – Demonstration of the new XM5 Android powered remote inventory device. The presentation also includes location inventory, container inventory, and physical inventories.

The Review Cycle – Various configurations are discussed and demonstrated. This includes checklists, multiple review steps, Notespacket, rejection of reviews, routing, and resetting reports.
